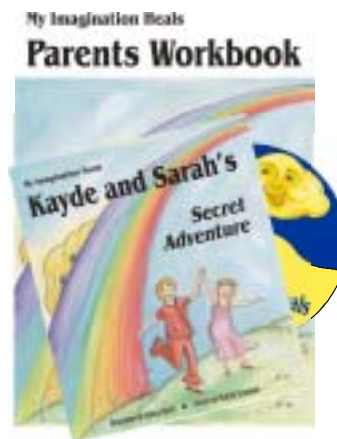

That was over ten years ago now, and things have changed."

I am very excited about the republishing, with the addition of the parents workbook, and great illustrations. This series has come to life!"
